Additional training may also count as fulfilling PMCDP course requirements. Review the **BLUE** column to determine other related training that may be granted equivalency. Remaining required courses are shown in the **ORANGE** column. You will be eligible for certification upon completion of all required training and experience requirements (see **GREEN** column).

\*\* Course work may be addressed in DoD leadership training or contract management training, but are not included in the DAU Program Management training. Applicant must provide supporting documentation (certificate, transcript, or other official documentation), of other completed equivalent courses (names and/or objectives) in order to receive course fulfillment.

\*\*\* 3 day Orientation Course to include topics from Project Management Systems and Practices in DOE and Project Execution and Operational Readiness Reviews.

\*\*\*\* PMCDP certification also requires demonstrated experience not addressed in this crosswalk.
