GENERAL

The contractor shall provide new recycled content carpet tiles, adhesive and installation in accordance with the specifications provided below. The contractor shall maintain an efficient and effective service in strict accordance with all terms, conditions, contract clauses, specifications and attachments contained herein or incorporated by reference.

Field Activities as Listed in Attachment 6 SPECIFICATIONS

1. Color, Pattern and Texture: The firm must manufacture all DOE Headquarters orders with the same color, pattern and texture for a minimum of (6) years after award.

2. Materials:

- a. Contractor must provide a written certification signed by the manufacturer's President or CEO or provide industry documentation or manufacturer literature showing that the material specifications listed below are met.
- b. DOE reserves the right to randomly test the awarded firm's carpet material to verify the amount of recycled materials. DOE may terminate the BPA for default for the contractor's failure to provide the required recycled content.
- c. Requirements:
 - Carpet fiber must be nylon and must contain a minimum recycled content of 33% by weight. Carpet backing must contain a minimum recycled content of 39% by weight. Carpet must contain a minimum total recycled content of 40% by total weight.
 - Carpet and installation materials must be CRI Green Label Certified.

3. Carpet Weight: Total carpet tile weight must be within the range of 24 to 32 ounces per square yard or have a face pile density of 6250 or above.

4. Used Carpet:

- a. The offeror will state that 100% of materials sold to DOE are recyclable into carpet or another consumer use products and thus will not be trashed, burned, or placed in a landfill.
- b. The contractor must provide a recycling service to include pick-up of all discarded DOE carpet (regardless of carpet type or manufacturer) from the locations listed above.
- c. When recycling DOE discarded carpet materials originating from another manufacturer recycled percentages are to be a minimum of 25% of face fiber and 39% of backing into carpet or another consumer use product.
- d. Contractor must provide a certification signed by the manufacturer's President or CEO that the recycled percentages for DOE discarded carpet will be met and documented in a monthly report to the DOE Contracting Officer's Representative.
- e. Contractor must provide "on call" freight pick-up service for the discarded carpet products when requested by the DOE Contracting Officer's Representative.
