
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The General Services Administration Integrated Acquisition Environment (IAE) Program Office is responsible for improving the Federal acquisition process through the reliance on a technology-based integrated infrastructure. The IAE seeks to implement the "Expanding Electronic Government" initiative outlined in the President's Management Agenda. The IAE Program Office is initiating a pilot, among other items, to make Federal contracts available to the general public on the worldwide web. This means that all contracts awarded would be available for public viewing, to increase transparency in agency acquisition activities.

The IAE Program Office is requesting public comment on this pilot to help identify priorities for implementation, such as, issues relative to security, FOIA/Privacy Act, scope of the pilot, or type of needed guidance. DOE contracting activities should provide any comments and/or concerns regarding this initiative to this office no later than July 25, 2003, to allow us time to prepare a consolidated response to the General Services Administration.
