

**SUMMARY:** Attached for your information is a letter entitled *Preventing Fraud in Federal Contracting* signed by the Deputy Administrator, Office of Federal Procurement Policy. The letter discusses the National Procurement Fraud Task Force which works with contracting and audit offices to more effectively detect and report fraud. The letter also discusses changes in the FAR to require contractors to disclose violations of law, establish internal controls, establish codes of business ethics, and train their employees in business ethics and to post fraud hotline posters in the work place.
